About the Organization:

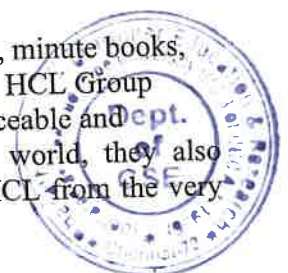

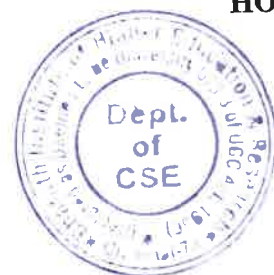
