About the Organization:

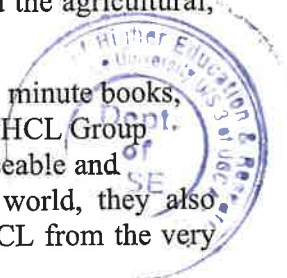
