#### About the Organization:

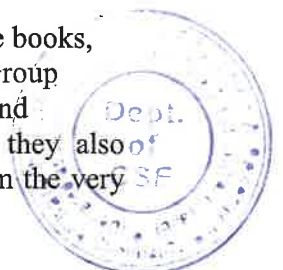

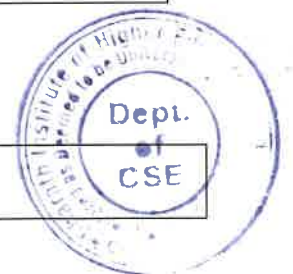
