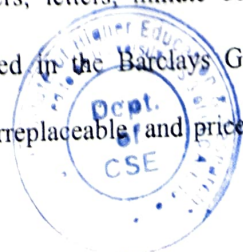
Objective of the Visit:

They don't just tell the story of Barclays' businesses around the world, they also communicate the strength and depth of the Values that have underpinned Barclays from the very beginning.

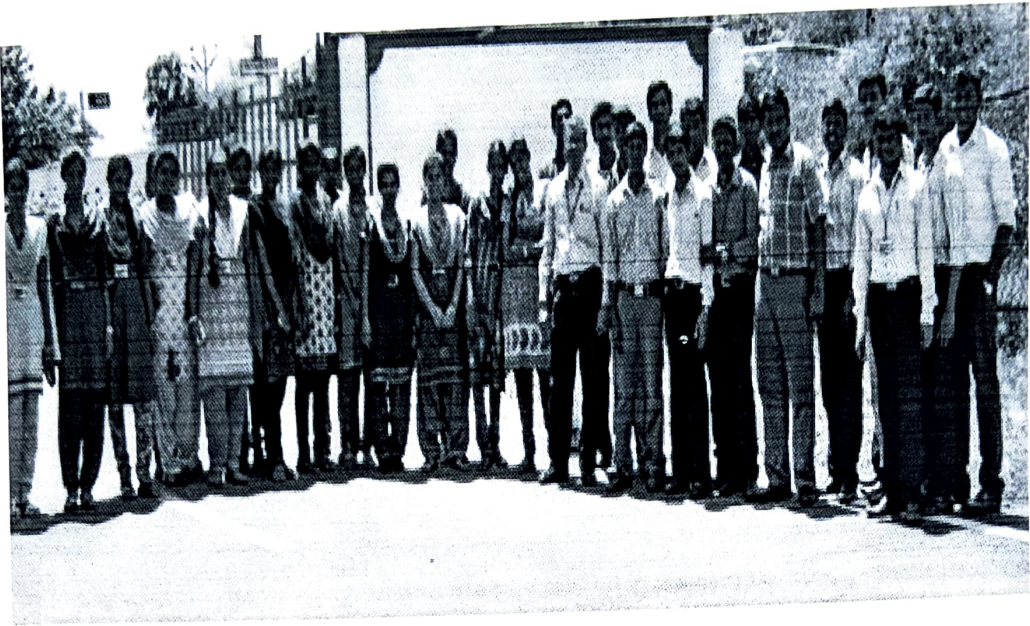
And it's not just the story of a bank – it is the story of the communities that we serve, as well as our colleagues, our buildings, and our products. The archives allow us to share those stories.

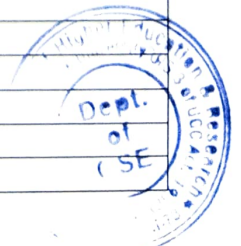
