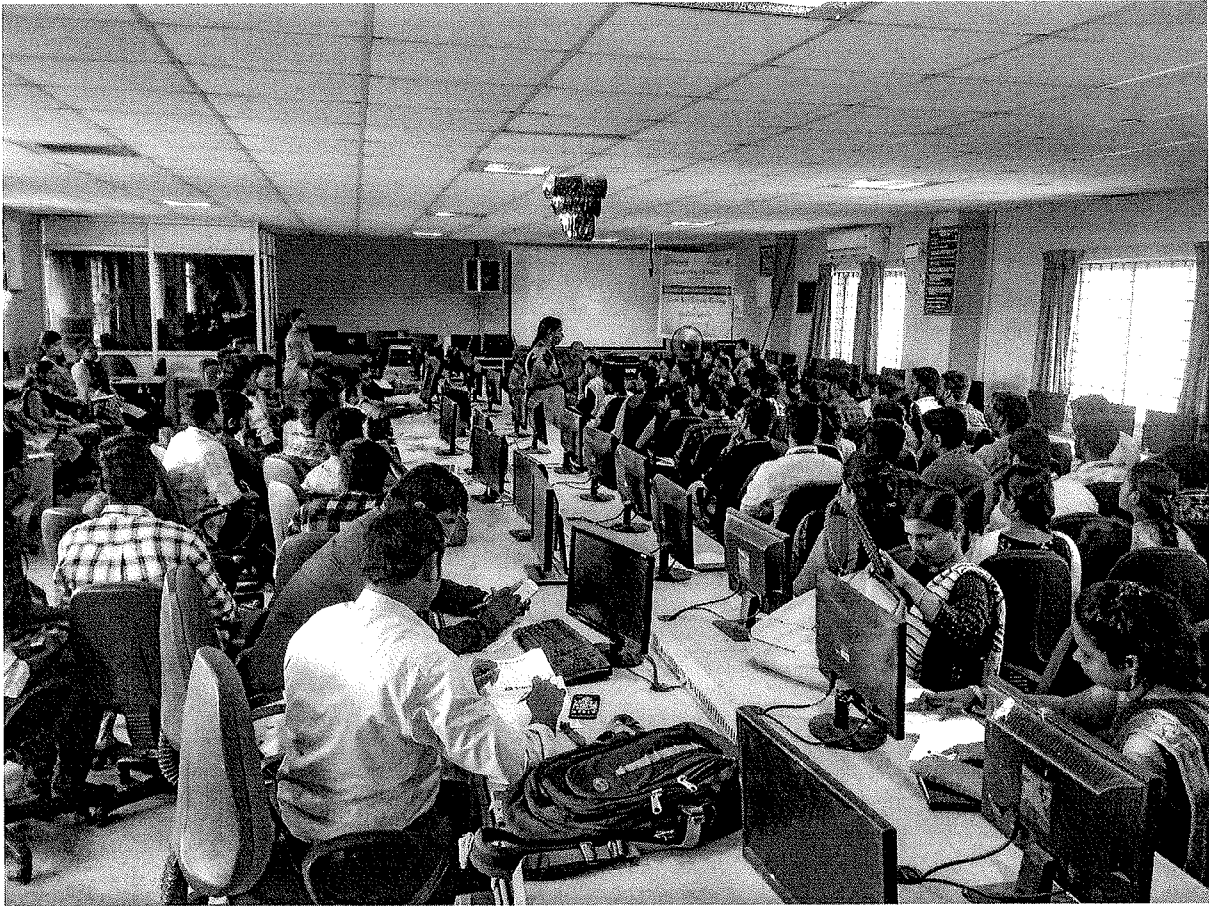
An Industrial Visit Report
