It is resolved to recommend to increase the credits as 3 instead 2 given already for the subject **Introduction to Fluid Mechanics**.

Resolution 3.2

It is resolved to recommend that the title can be changed for the subject "Material Testing and Evaluation" as "Building Material & Testing Methods"

Resolution 3.3

It is resolved to recommend to change the subject title "**Reinforced Concrete**" as "**Reinforced Concrete Design**".

Resolution 3.4

It is resolved to recommend the following reorder of the units in the subject Geotechnical Engineering as,

- \Box Unit 1 Site Investigation
- \Box Unit 2 Retaining Wall (Interchanged the unit title)

Resolution 3.5

It is resolved to recommend to change the unit title and to rearrange the units in the subject **Environmental Engineering** as,

- □ The title of **Unit 1** -**Introduction** is to be changed as "**Water Quality & Treatment**"
- □ The **Unit IV** title and its subtopics are to be put under Unit II and renamed as Water Distribution System. The present Unit II and its subtopics will be given as **Unit IV**.
- □ The Unit V Water Supply and Drainage in Building is renamed as "Design of Sewerage System" and termed as Unit III. The present Unit III Air & Noise Control is to be accommodated under Unit V.
