# PRINCIPLES OF PLASTIC SURGERY AND BURN CARE BURNS & PLASTIC SURGERY

COURSE OUTLINE:

This course / workshop is designed for undergraduates. The course intends to give comprehensive knowledge on surgical etiquettes and basic skills required to carry out surgical procedures in their own practise or when need arises.
