The Certificate in Global Health and the associated study abroad program expands opportunities for Clemson University students from health-related disciplines. The program moves beyond the standard "language and culture" model of study abroad to provide an inter professional and integrated approach to the challenge of health care delivery across global settings. Focused on the societal issues that influence health care in low resource countries, this program will prepare students to address health disparities in domestic or international settings.

1. synthesize knowledge of current global health issues and assist local health care partners to develop innovative strategies to improve health outcomes in low resource settings;
2. increase cultural competence in health care delivery;
3. strengthen skills for working with indigenous and/or underserved populations;
