#### **Acceptance and Enrolment Deadline**

You must also enrol into the course and subjects by the deadline specified on this offer letter.

Students need to be in Melbourne prior to the commencement of classes on Monday 29 January 2024. Orientation will be held in the week before classes start.

#### **Student Placement Requirements**

As part of your course you will be required to undertake study in a clinical environment. In order to undertake these placements, you must meet certain conditions as set out by the University of Melbourne and its clinical partners. These conditions have been determined under the guidance of the

If you have been granted and accept advanced standing in your course the course duration may change, which in turn will change the Overseas Student Health Cover you are required to purchase. 


