## 4. To inform the Achievement of BIHER in NIRF Ranking, ABET Accreditation & UGC-AICTE combined Inspection

Dr. V. Kanagasabai, Vice Chancellor proudly informed the members of PMB that BIHER has been ranked by the NIRF - 2017-18 as

No:2 in Outreach and Inclusivity

No:5 among Private Universities in India

Ranked no: 21 among All Universities in India

Ranked no:35 in Overall Category

He also informed that four of the Depts viz.,

EEE, ECE, Civil & Mechanical Engg have been Accredited by Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET), USA for 6 years till the academic year 2023-24.

Sree Balaji Medical College & Hospital was Accredited by NABL till 24<sup>th</sup> July 2020.

He further informed that UGC-AICTE expert committee expected to visit all the constituent colleges of BIHER during by November 2017.

### **Suggestions of the UGC-AICTE Expert Committee**

- The University should encourage student exchanges with other Institutions in India and abroad.
- It is desirable to start super speciality programmes in various medical disciplines at both Chennai, Puducherry campuses.
- The Clinical material needs to be further augmented.
- Although University has made reasonable strides in research activities, however further impetus in this direction should be made.
- The Engineering Faculty be further motivated for innovative, collaborative and start up oriented research.
- The Biomedical waste management at individual clinical level should strengthened.

AICTE suggested model curriculum for UG & PG and MBA programmes and after detailed discussion it was decided to follow the model with minor modifications depending on the specific requirements of the respective programmes. The new Academic Regulations R2018, curriculum and syllabus following the AICE Model curriculum and syllabus will be implemented with effect from the batches admitted in July 2018 onwards.

B.Pharm & D.Pharm Programmes are started in Sree Balaji Medical College Campus during the academic year 2018-19 with the approval Pharmacy Council of India and AICTE

B. Sc (Hons) Agriculture with intake capacity of 60 is started in BIST Campus during the current academic year 2018-19 with the approval of UGC

An proposal has been sent to Pharmacy Council of India to start B.Pharm & D. Pharm Programmes in the BIST Campus.

It was expressed that the AICTE model curriculum to be implemented in stages. After due deliberations it was decided to record and recommended to BOM
